PIAM Progetto Integrazione Accoglienza Migranti


PIAM, Progetto Integrazione Accoglienza Migranti, is a lay association, mainly composed f of Italian and foreign social workers, based in Asti. We carry out social and cultural activities at national and international level.

Since 2000, we have been working on the fight against trafficking, with integrated interventions and social protection programmes in favour of women and men who are victims of trafficking and exploitation.

Since 2011 we have been running reception and integration projects for asylum seekers, refugees and displaced persons.

- We focus on the individual right to have a better future
- · We create spaces and educational paths for the children we host, because they are the citizens of tomorrow
- · We also propose promote local development, through land reuse and cultivation of ancient grains
- We develop, test and share good practises in the filed of immigrants' reception, to be shared at national and international level

Our budget figures (calculation on the **2020** budget of **1.881.432 euros**). We long for a cohesive society and a reception system that does not take away resources, but creates them.



2021, we welcomed **206 people** of different nationalities, including **25 children**.

Trafficking and prostitution

OUR MISSION

The main mission of PIAM Association is to support integration and autonomy programmes for victims of trafficking (VoTs), with a special focus on victims of sexual exploitation.

In Italy prostitution is legal, exploitation is against the law.

We meet different types of women on the streets. Support and help are provided not only to those who are forced into prostitution but also to women who work voluntarily. Contact takes place on the streets and indoor (prostitution, also as a result of the pandemic, is changing, moving indoors).

We provide anti-trafficking counselling in first reception centres for migrants: cultural mediators meet migrant women and carry out deep investigations on the nature of the migration process. The risks of human trafficking are discussed, as well as the possibility of joining social protection schemes and thus avoiding traffickers and exploitation.

PREVENTION

Health care is offered to all women who come into contact with us in our services. Specifically, the aim is to prevent the spread of HIV and other sexually transmitted infections (STIs). Providing health care is the first step to establish a trust relationship of with women involved in prostitution, that may even lead to the decision to "quit the streets" and join a protection and integration programme.

The work carried out by the social workers of PIAM aims to provide assistance to all women involved in prostitution and to improve their living conditions, without forcing them to sell their bodies for this purpose.

We do not stigmatise and we do not discriminate







Trafficking and prostitution

PIAM anti-trafficking organization

PIAM is the anti-trafficking organization of the Anello Forte project in the province of Asti, which is coordinated by the Piedmont Region and aims to assist victims of trafficking and serious exploitation (art.18 D.Lgs 286/98).

The activities of the Anello Forte project are mainly three:

- 1. FIRST CONTACT (street unit, drop in center, indoor activities, interviews in the Territorial Commission, support to CAS and SAI centres).
- 2. PROTECTION AND FIRST ASSISTANCE (management of escape houses, health and legal assistance)
- 3. RESIDENTIAL RECEPTION (management of accommodation, legal protection, economic support for bureaucratic and health expenses, psychological support, cultural mediation, education, occupational workshops, strengthening of relational skills).

PIAM also hosts women victims of trafficking in the framework of FAMI project "ALFA (Accogliere le Fragilità)", funded by the European Union and coordinated by the Prefecture of Turin.

We are also involved in **cultural mediation activities at the border of Ventimiglia**, for women and minors in transit or returning from other countries, in collaboration with Save The Children.



Local development





RURITAGE

The RURITAGE project is funded by the European Commission and is part of the H2020 programme.

RURITAGE is led by the University of Bologna and includes 38 partners from 14 EU countries, plus Iceland, Norway, Turkey and Colombia.

RURITAGE, through the enhancement of cultural and natural heritage, intends to transform rural areas into laboratories of sustainable development to build a **new approach to rural regeneration**.

The project promotes a new form of collaboration between local actors and communities by involving them in a participatory, community-based management of natural and cultural heritage, ensuring its management, development and transfer of skills and expertise.

Among the several organisations that have successfully tested regeneration strategies based on the cultural and natural heritage of rural areas, **PIAM Onlus was selected as Role Model in the Migration field**.

Our experience in implementing integration processes that have facilitated local development has been rewarded with this prestigious award













8 BASSO MONFERRATO Active tourism between nature and culture

"8 Basso Monferrato. Active tourism between nature and culture" started in 2019 from the initiative of the PIAM Onlus association of Asti. The oaim of the project is the recovery and valorisation of the trails in the north-west Asti area, where PIAM has been managing SAI projects for many years, in collaboration with the local municipal administrations.

The municipalities of Chiusano d'Asti, Castellero, Monale and Cortandone first joined the project, followed by OpenLab computer laboratory of Asti, the Department of Science, Design and Territorial Policy of the Turin Polytechnic and BEWOOD OUTDOOR BRIGADE.

"8 Basso Monferrato" is a tourist offer, **based on the creation of a trail circuit**, which is today about 80 km long, practicable on foot, by bike and on horseback, that connects the most relevant points of interest in the area (Romanesque art, castles, landscapes, nature sites, etc.).

The project is intended to produce positive effects in terms of:

- Greater usability of the paths
- Improvement and expansion of recreational and tourist activities in the area
- Promotion of slow and sustainable tourism
- Increasing the flow of visitors
- Creation of an innovative, virtuous and ethical model of promotion and development of the area















FIELDS OF VILLA QUAGLINA

Villa Quaglina is the former Seminary of the Oblates of San Giuseppe in Asti.

A beautiful villa from the last century surrounded by greenery, with an adjacent farmhouse and six hectares of arable land, the complex had not been used for years before being taken over. In 2014, the CO.AL.A Consortium and PIAM Onlus gave new life to this complex, starting to host refugees and displaced persons.

In this context, the project to enhance and preserve Piedmontese agri-food excellence was developed. The large plot of land became a social enterprise, with the rediscovery and planting of ancient crops, such as: red Ottofile maize, yellow Marano maize, buckwheat ancient Verna wheat, ancient southern wheat and Maracan, which are processed in collaboration with the Cesare Quaglia farm in Variglie and transformed into flour and pasta. With the precious work of the people welcomed.









THE TRATTORIA VILLA QUAGLINA Solidarity catering

With a mind to interpreting reception from a new point of view, a reception contextualised in the territory, and which brings additional value to the territory, a new adventure was born.

That of Trattoria Villa Quaglina: the new osteria that we have opened in the location of a reception centre for migrants, Villa Quaglina, the former Seminary of the Oblates of San Giuseppe surrounded by greenery on the outskirts of Asti. It is the first osteria of this kind in Italy. It is a way to promote local development, to promote typical local products (in particular the flour and pasta that we produce in the Villa Quaglina fields with the help of migrants), to create jobs and activities that have a positive impact not only on immigration itself, but also on the local context.

The word 'osteria', in the Italian language implies colours, scents, mixtures, cultures to be discovered. Freedom of expression and enjoyment.

Bringing people into a migrant reception centre means real inclusion. Opening up to society, so that society opens up to us. And what better way to do this than to invite people to spend pleasant and tasty hours at our tables? We want this restaurant to be a place of entertainment, of good food, but also of inclusion, where everyone, can feel at ease.

The restaurant offers a catering service, an opportunity to create new jobs.









STELLA LAKE Green Classroom – Castellero

"Aula Verde Lago Stella" is a park dedicated to the theme of biodiversity, designed to **educate on environmental sustainability** through play activities and to support people in difficulty through participatory and inclusive activities. After being closed for two years, the historic sport fishing lake has been managed since 2020 by the social cooperative Argo in collaboration with PIAM. The lake is home to some fish that are very popular with anglers, such as black bass, chub and carp. No-kill fishing is offered.

We also shelter 15 donkeys, with whom it is possible to take walks and do assisted intervention activities.

The project envisages the redevelopment of the area, aimed at returning it to public use, enhancing natural resources and social inclusion.

The proposed activities are part of the local experience of integrated reception and the relationships that the SAI project and the local authorities have managed to establish with the local institutions.

INCLUSIVE TERRITORIES COSÌ PROJECT

Comuni Solidali e Inclusivi

The COSI'-Comuni Solidali e Inclusivi (Solidarity and Inclusive Municipalities) project aims to strengthen the territorial network supporting people in fragile conditions, especially those with a migration background, through a process of training, comparison, synergy and development of human, natural and material resources present in the area today.

The projects involves the municipalities of Chiusano, Cortandone, Settime, Castellero and Monale (territory in which PIAM Onlus is the implementing body of the SAI Agape project for the integrated reception and inclusion programmes for asylum seekers and refugees).

The project is divided into different types of services

HOME CARE SERVICES: the project will identify persons living in the territories involved who may need home care, such as elderly people or people with disabilities, and will offer home care services employing women who have been previously trained.

LOCAL TRANSPORT SERVICE: the "social taxi" is a transport service addressed to people with physical impairment or lacking means of transportation, to allow them to travel to family members, medical clinics, shops, or join the activies at Lago Stella.

The involvement of local inhabitants is fundamental, through information and cultural mediation actions to encourage people to participate in the services and activities offered.

4 AREAS OF INTERVENTION

Educational area

In 2021, we developed several projects specifically dedicated to children in our reception centres. We believe that these children are the the citizens of tomorrow, and that it is necessary to rethink the world of childcare. With projects, spaces and staff dedicated to the youngest. In particular, the most fragile families, single parents, such as women who have escaped trafficking and their children.

Together with the Piedmontese Anti-trafficking Network, PIAM is involved in a national research and experimentation group that aims to improve the care of children of women victims of trafficking and strengthen the parental skills of mothers.

The aim is to **draw up guidelines** on the care of single-parent families to be used in national reception programmes

Activities started in 2021:

OPENING OF "SCUOLINA": a small kindergardn set up at the Seminary's reception facility, Casa Alfa, which currently hosts 7 children (ages 1-3 years). , to carry out activities with professional childcare educators.

The creation of a new space dedicated to children was also planned, a project that was presented publicly with a fundraising campaign launched at the end of 2021.

PARTICIPATORY OBSERVATION OF THE CHILDREN by the teachers through guided play, evaluation drills, the identification of possible critical issues, with periodic reports on the cases and the activities carried out.

PARENTING WORKSHOPS: addressed to 8 mothers hosted at the Seminario structure, on practical topics such as managing time with children, managing "crises and tantrums", nutrition, play, the relationship between family and school, knowledge of useful services in the area.

CREATION OF INTEGRATED COLLABORATIVE RELATIONSHIPS between caregivers and local social services.

CONNECTION AND EXCHANGE with the school network.

RESEARCH-STUDY initiated with other partners of the Piedmontese Anti-trafficking network to improve child care and strengthening mothers' parental skills.

"LAGO STELLA" SUMMER CENTRE (approximately 30 local children - duration 6 weeks)

"LAGO STELLA" INTERNAL SUMMER CENTRE (approximately 6 children included in Piam reception projects - duration 2 weeks).

FAMILY WORKSHOPS AT "LAGO STELLA": outdoor educational activities aimed at strengthening children's relational skills, on the themes of biodiversity, environmental sustainability and the relationship between man and animal. Open to children from our reception centres and to local families.

5 AREAS OF INTERVENTION

Socio-educational services

For the management of the housing emergency of families in fragile and vulnerable conditions

The attention to the territory and its fragilities - which include but are not limited to the theme of migration - is the driving force behind a new project we are working on: the entrusting of the socio-educational service for the management of the housing emergency of families in fragile and vulnerable conditions, in agreement with and in support of the activities of the Municipality of Asti - Social Policies, Education, Educational Services Sector, both ordinary and emergency. The service involves the management of problems related to the housing emergency as a whole.

The objective is to plan a path for families in housing distress that helps them manage the "housing problem": finding accommodation and supporting them to better manage their daily lives.

The project is divided into two phases:

MAPPING PLACES AND RESOURCES, contacting house owners, real estate agencies, and identification of potential partners.

IDENTIFYING OTHER POTENTIAL PARTNERS for real estate search, renovation projects or other forms of collaboration. Afterwards, the project will tackle the issue of housing emergency, will carry out interviews with families reported by the Department of Social Services, monitoring and coordination activities with the Department itself.





Reception at the time of COVID

All beneficiaries were promptly informed about the behavior they should adopt in order to avoid the spread of infection and preserve their own and others' health. Social workers and cultural mediators played a fundamental role in this process raising awareness, in order to make guests understand the importance of the adoption of prevention measures against the spread of the virus.

All reception facilities were equipped with hygiene products and all measures were adopted to provide for adequate prevention, so that we were able to carry out our activities in full safety.

In collaboration with the association "Migrantes", Piam managed a small project ("Food Not Virus"), to provide food for foreign citizens most affected by the pandemic. PIAM produced online guides in English and French for accessing the shopping vouchers provided by the Municipality of Asti, also providing telephone help in filling out the application.

The association took part in the "Dona la spesa" network, in collaboration with the Municipality of Asti, Caritas, the Red Cross, and other voluntary associations. 160 food aid items were delivered. These activities counterbalanced the social distance generated by the pandemic, promoting solidarity and mutual help.
